WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 89 of the Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act, S.A. 1994, c. F-18.5, as amended ("the Act"), the Summer Village of Sunset Beach ("the Municipality") must designate by bylaw, or other legal instrument, a person or group of persons as the head of the Municipality for the purposes of the Act; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Sections 87 and 89 of the Act the Municipality may set any fees payable to the Municipality for services under the Act and Regulations thereunder;

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the Summer Village of Sunset Beach in the Province of Alberta enacts as follows; that

- 1. For the purposes of the Act the person appointed by Council to the position of Chief Administrative Officer, established by Bylaw #88 1998, is designated as the Head of the Municipality; and
- Where an Applicant under the Act is required to pay a fee for services, the fee payable is in accordance with the Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Regulation, AR 200/95, as amended from time to time or any successor Regulation that sets fees for requests for information from the Province.
