NOTICE OF DECISION

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**Re: Development Permit Application No. 24DP01
Plan 4894NY, Block 1, Lot 2 : 302 Willow Drive (the "Lands")
R1 – Residential District : Summer Village of Sunset Beach**

Preamble: The development approved under this permit includes:

- a) Demolishing existing cabin and building a new 3015 sq.ft. house. A Variance has been granted for a maximum height of 30.9'. The house must not exceed this height.

APPROVAL OF DEVELOPMENT PERMIT

You are hereby notified that your application for a development permit with regard to the following:

All Items

has been **APPROVED** subject to the following conditions:

1. Based on the wetland report, you will be required to have a wetland assessment done to determine if any unique construction methods are required based on the location of possible wetlands.
2. A professional surveyor is required to do a stakeout prior to the build beginning to ensure proper location.
3. An RPR is required to be submitted to the Summer Village of Sunset Beach showing that the building was built in the proper location.
4. All municipal taxes must be paid.
5. The applicant shall provide a certified copy of plan of subdivision to determine all easements and restrictive covenants on the parcel, and 8.5 X 11 copies of site plans of a quality satisfactory to the Development Officer.
6. The applicant shall obtain and adhere to the requirements where applicable, from the

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appropriate authority, permits relating to demolition, building, electricity, plumbing and drainage, and all other permits required in connection with the proposed development.

7. The applicant shall be financially responsible during construction for any damage by the applicant, his servants, his suppliers, agents or contractors, to any public or private property.
8. The applicant shall prevent excess soil or debris from being spilled on public streets and lanes; and shall not place soil or any other material on adjacent properties without permission in writing from adjacent property owners.
9. The improvements take place in accordance with the plans and sketches submitted as part of the permit application.
10. All improvements shall be completed within twelve (12) months of the effective date of the permit.
11. The applicant is responsible for designing and constructing a building foundation drainage system adequate for the existing soil conditions.
12. The applicant is responsible for determining if there are any special considerations required for building foundation construction.
13. The site and improvements thereon shall be maintained in a clean and tidy condition during construction, free from rubbish and debris. Receptacles for the purpose of disposing of rubbish and debris shall be provided to prevent scatter of debris and rubbish.
14. No person shall keep or permit to be kept in any part of a yard any excavation, storage or piling of materials required during the construction stage unless all necessary safety measures are undertaken. The owner of such materials or excavation must assume full responsibility to ensure the situation does not prevail any longer than reasonably necessary to complete a particular stage of construction.
15. The applicant is responsible for meeting all requirements listed in the Summer Village of Sunset Beach Land Use Bylaw which is available on the summer village website.
